Subject : NO GIFT POLICY

According to the Cabinet resolution on December ๘, ๒๐๒๐, the country's reform plan was approved for prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct. (revised edition) with a drive to carry out important reform activities (BIG ROCK) Reform activity number ๔: Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and devoid of benefits. Goal No. ๑, Section ๑.๑, "Have all government agencies declare themselves to be agencies in which all government officials do not accept gifts and presents of any kind in the performance of duties (NO GIFT POLICY)".

In this regard, to drive forward the above national reform activities. Create transparency within the agency Create values in performing duties And relying on the practice of honesty as a culture of honesty, the Subdistrict Administrative Organization of Chiat Subdistrict has therefore announced a policy for all executives, employees, officers, and personnel to not accept gifts and gifts of any kind from the performance of duties (NO GIFT POLICY). Every festival and special occasion Except in cases of necessity and unavoidability, the rules for accepting gifts or gratuities must be followed. and any other benefits in accordance with the regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by government officials, B.E. ๒๐๐๑, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the criteria for receiving property or other benefits according to the ethics of government officials. ๒๐๒๐

Therefore, it is announced for everyone to know. and all executives, officers, and personnel under the supervision shall continue to strictly abide by the policy.

Announced on January ๓, ๒๐๒๔ onwards.
